

2021 POOL SEASON PASSES

Overlook & Skyline Pools NEW Registration Procedure



REGISTER ON-LINE AT MANHEIMTOWNSHIP.ORG BEGINNING APRIL 15, 2021.

Pool Season Passes are available to Manheim Township Residents and Non-Residents. Season Pass Categories include: Individual, Double, Family (up to 6 household family members) and Senior (Age 60+ for RESIDENTS ONLY).

EACH FAMILY MEMBER OF THE HOUSEHOLD WILL NEED TO BE REGISTERED FOR A PASS.

Pool Season Passes

EXISTING ACCOUNT:

- If you have registered with us before for ANYTHING, including programs, season pool passes, or a Township ID card, **you already have an account.** If you forgot your password, please follow the "Forgot Password Instructions".
- If you no longer know the email or have changed the email address associated with this account, you will have to get approval from the Recreation Department, to verify your account. This approval will be done within one (1) business day of your request.
- **Important! Date of births must be included for all family members in order to register. If DOB is not included please email (parksrec@manheimtownship.org) or call the Recreation Office at 717-290-7180, Ext. 3100, so we can include it.**

CREATING A NEW ACCOUNT:

- Click the "Create an Account" and answer the questions.
- Be sure to add ALL family members in your household.
- All **NEW** accounts must be approved by the Recreation Department.
- The request for approval will automatically be sent to the Department. This approval will be done within one (1) business day of your request.
- You will then receive an email with log on instructions.

WHY DO WE NEED TO VERIFY YOUR ACCOUNT?

- We do this to ensure new accounts are identified under the appropriate resident / non-resident status.

REMINDER IF YOU ARE CREATING A NEW ACCOUNT -OR- FORGET YOUR E-MAIL ADDRESS CONNECTED TO THIS ACCOUNT:

- You will have to get approval from the Recreation Department. The request for approval will automatically be sent to the Recreation Department. This approval will be done within one (1) business day of your request
- Once approved, you will receive an email with log on instructions.

IMPORTANT: If you have NOT logged into your account recently, we suggest that you log in and verify that everything is correct, prior to the opening of the April 15 Pool registration.

Our goal is to ensure participants for our programs and pool season pass holders have easy access to online registration. The first step is making sure your account is up to date and you know your user name and password.

POOL SEASON PASS CLASSIFICATION

FAMILY DEFINITION: Overlook and Skyline Outdoor Pools -

- **Double Season Pass Classifications** consist of two (2) individuals residing in the same household.
- **Family Season Pass Classification** consist of a **MAXIMUM** of two (2) Adults and their dependents under 23 years of age residing in the same household.

Note: Families of seven (7) or more will require approval from the Recreation Department prior to on-line registration.

**Proof of dependency may be requested if a situation is warranted.*

- **A resident discount** is given to those people whose primary residence is in Manheim Township. Non-residents pay standard rates.
- **Season passes are non-transferable.** Unauthorized use results in automatic loss of season pass.
- **Season Pass Refunds** will only be given before the Pool \ Season begins and will be assessed a \$15 administrative fee. **There are no Season Pass refunds after the pools open!**

POOLS IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

For the safety of all of our patrons, Manheim Township issued photo ID cards are required of all users for admission to the pool facilities! This includes resident and non-resident **DAILY ADMISSION PATRONS** as well as **POOL SEASON PASS HOLDERS**. The ID cards may be used at either pool for admission and are included free with the purchase of your Pool Season Pass!

- 1.) **If you already have a card, you do not need to purchase a new one!** When you register for a Pool Season Pass, your household members will be activated in our system accordingly.
- 2.) **ID cards must be presented for admission to the pools. No card, No entrance.**
- 3.) **DAILY ADMISSION PATRONS:** ID cards cost \$4 per resident (*maximum fee of \$15 per family*) and \$6 per non-resident (*maximum fee of \$20 per family*). Replacement fee for a lost, damaged or stolen card is \$6.
- 4.) Save time and avoid waiting at the pool by getting your ID cards at Stauffer Mansion before the pools open!

2021 POOL RULES

Our first priority is your safety and well-being while you visit our pools. We encourage everyone to know and understand our pool rules.

- Manheim Township issued ID card must be presented for admission.
- Children under age 12 must be supervised by an adult aged 18 or older.
- Infants and children who are not toilet trained are permitted in the pool but must wear a swim diaper.
- The only acceptable floatation device for the non-swimmer is U.S. Coast Guard approved Personal Floatation Devices (life vests or approved wings).
- No running, pushing, dunking or horseplay.
- Inflatables are not permitted. This includes: inner tubes, rafts, beach balls, noodles.
- All Swimmers must be attired in apparel designed for swimming and aquatic activity use.
- Alcohol and drugs are not permitted.
- Smoking & Vaping are not permitted in or around the fenced in pool area and buildings.
- Abusive or profane language or activity will not be tolerated.
- No weapons of any kind are permitted.
- No glass of any kind is permitted.
- Cellular phone, phone camera, camera and video camera use are strictly prohibited in all public locker, shower and changing areas.
- No pets are allowed in the pool area at the time.

Attention: All persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. Management does not assume responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use.

POOL SEASON VIRTUAL Guest Passes

As a benefit to season pass holders, each pass holder gets one (1) free virtual guest pass per family member up to 6 per family maximum.

Each guest pass allows a one-time use. Guest must enter with the Pool Season Pass Holder and must complete the Pool ID information sheet at the front desk at the Pool.

Season pass holders will be held responsible for their guest's behavior and conduct.

2021 Season Pass Holder Guest Passes are VIRTUAL and are automatically issued with the on-line purchase of your Pool Season Pass. No paper guest passes need to be picked up at the Recreation Office!

2021 POOL SEASON SCHEDULE

SKYLINE Pool will open Saturday, 5/29 and will close Sunday, 8/8/21.
OVERLOOK Pool will open Saturday, 6/5 and will close Monday, 9/6/21.

This annual closure procedure is necessary due to limited staff, economic considerations, and school opening and closing dates.
